## COLLINGSWOOD SWIM TEAM

As a member of the Suburban Swim League, the Recreation Department sponsors a swim team open to all residents from age 5 to under 18. Recreational and competitive concepts are incorporated in this program. **Children must pass a beginners test** and be 5 years old  
**Supervisor:** Recreational staff  
**Dates:** June through mid-August  
**Days:** Practice at Roberts Pool begins June 4th .  
 Meets held Saturday mornings or Wednesday evenings.  
**Fee:** \$60 each for first two swimmers per family, \$35 each additional family member.



## RESIDENCY AND PAYMENT REQUIREMENTS

All recreation programs, excluding Roberts Pool, are for Collingswood residents ONLY. Proof of Collingswood residency will be required to acquire passes or register for any program or activity. Receipts will be provided. No refunds once program has begun.  
**\$5 Late fee will be assessed after June 20**
