RESIDENCY AND PAYMENT REQUIREMENTS

All recreation programs, excluding Roberts Pool, are for Collingswood residents ONLY. Proof of Collingswood residency will be required to acquire passes or register for any program or activity. Receipts will be provided. No refunds once program has begun.

\$5 Late fee will be assessed after June 23

EARLY MORNING SWIM

Roberts Pool will be open Monday thru Friday during the summer season from 6am to 8am for adults and senior citizens. Early morning swim begins June 21.

SWIMMING - SENIOR CITIZENS

Roberts Pool will be open to Senior Citizens ONLY for one 1/2 hour prior to the regular opening. Senior Citizens can enjoy the pool themselves from 11am - 11:30am, 7 days a week.

11AM - 11:30AM will be SENIORS ONLY

One side of 50 meter pool will be open to Seniors ONLY from 11:30am to 12 noon
All Senior Citizens must have a pool tag. ** Senior Swim starts June 19**

COURT AND PLAYGROUND PASSES

All residents are required to have resident identification passes when using community basketball, tennis, hockey courts and playgrounds. These passes will be available to all residents at the registration nights. Proof of residency is required to obtain pass. This policy will be enforced through the police department and persons without passes will be asked to leave.

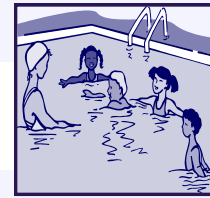

Swimmers will compete in freestyle, backstroke, breaststroke and butterfly, as well as medley relays, individual medley, freestyle relays and, new this year, a 200-meter freestyle event. Ribbons will be awarded to the top male and female swimmers within their age categories. Swimmers age 19+ are invited to participate.
