Recycling



The Borough is pleased to announce the implementation of Single Stream Recycling. Mix all your recycling into one container; glass, paper and plastics together in your blue recycling container.

Mixed recycling will be collected on your scheduled trash pick up day. All types of paper and cardboard are acceptable and may be mixed together. You may keep paper separate in brown paper bags if preferred (**no plastic bags**). Collectors will be able to accept cardboard boxes that are broken down and bundled together. Boxes are an ideal way to place your paper and other recyclables in for collection. Please try to limit the boxes to 3x3x3 in size.

Cans, glass and plastics should be washed as clean as possible removing all lids and caps. Remember: Only #1 and #2 plastics are acceptable. All these items should be placed in the blue recycling container provided to residents by the Borough. If you need an additional container, please stop by the Public Works Department at 713 N. Atlantic Ave. (next to the water towers) between 7 a.m. & 3 p.m.

Solid Waste



South Jersey Sanitation is the contractor for solid waste and recycling for our Borough. Call 856-772-9899 for additional information.

COLLECTION TIME: Please place solid waste and recyclables out after 5 p.m. on the night before pickup or before 6 a.m. on your collection day. Solid waste and recyclables should be placed curbside, not in gutters or on sidewalk.

CONTAINERS: Plastic or metal trash containers no larger than 3' x 3' x 3', weighing no more than 50 lbs. Watertight heavy-duty plastic trash bags are also acceptable. **Do not** use blue recycling containers for trash.

BULK ITEMS: Household appliances, furniture, etc. may be discarded with the normal solid waste, except during the holidays. Limit of 2 per week. Any refrigerant item must have coolant (freon) removed prior to pick up. It is recommended that during the time of purchase, have vendor dispose of old item. **No construction debris accepted.**

COMMERCIAL: Commercial properties will be picked up, subject to a limitation of six-50 pound packages per pickup per property or 300 pounds.

MOTOR OIL: Bring used motor oil to Borough Garage. Must be in a sealed, marked container.

Yard waste & brush



SMALL BRUSH: Small brush may either be loose in cans (**absolutely no plastic bags** will be accepted) or tied in bundles. May through September for yard waste recycling.

LARGE BRUSH: Anything over 4" in diameter will be picked up by the Public Works Department. This should be placed at curbside loose, not tied. Please call 856-858-0533 for pickup.

GRASS: Grass must be placed loose in cans with **NO LIDS** (**absolutely no plastic bags** will be accepted). May through September.

LEAF: Leaf collection begins in mid-October though mid-December. Please make sure leaves are placed on the curbstrip - not the street.

CHRISTMAS TREES: Collection will be handled by the Public Works Department. Please place at curbside on your trash day.

Schedule



The Borough provides weekly collection of solid waste and recycling. There are six holidays that collection will not take place: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. Collection will take place the day after these holidays.

Collings Avenue to High Speed Line (PATCO)
White Horse Pike to Champion Avenue
Newton Avenue to Crescent Boulevard/Includes Woodlyne Avenue (Clay) and 300
400 blocks of Park Avenue

TUESDAY:

Bellevue Terrace up to and including Knight Avenue
PATCO High Speed Line to South Cooper River Drive

WEDNESDAY: No pick up

THURSDAY:

High Speed Line (PATCO) to S. Newton Lake Drive
Lakeview Drive to Haddon Township Border
Bettlewood Avenue to Browning Road
Collings Avenue to N. Newton Lake Drive

FRIDAY:

Harvard Avenue to Haddon Township Border
PATCO High Speed Line to Haddon Twp. Border and South
Cooper River Drive
Maple and Highland Ave. from Knight Ave. to Woodlawn Ave
